- Democracy index
 - SA ranked at 41
 - 22nd flawed democracies
 - Ranked 4th in Africa

 - available resources & positive outcomes potential
 - negative consequences history & choices
- Realities what now?
 - Where we come from!
 - Where we want to go?

Changes influencing South Africa

- Global changes political & socio-economic
- South Africa is changing rapidly
 - a growing/ young population
 - urbanised vs rural
 - socio-economic changes
- Demographic trends & governance
 - migration 2 provinces
 - urbanisation 61% increasing to +70% & +80%
 - population growth institutional & service requirements
 - Decline in levels of participation

- ANC & government
 - developments within the ANC and alliance
 - policy challenges & uncertainty
 - outcomes of leadership elections of December 2017
- developments in other political parties
 - DA especially the WC & Cape Town
 - EFF
 - Other parties
- Increasing importance of civil society & media
 - Role of business?

Key issues affecting South Africa

- Tensions resulting from poor governance
 - party and state
 - policy & ideology = the NDP?
 - local & provincial government
 - corruption & scandal
- Weakening institutions
 - decay in capacity of government & institutions
- Political parties
 - weakening dominant elite & elite fragmentation
 - leadership
 - plan/ vision?
 - questionable decisions
 - accountability?
 - approach to constitution/institutions?

Immediate (& future) threats?

- Potential for conflict (violence?) in SA
 - access to positions/ resources
 - control of government/ distribution of resources
 - alienation & fragmentation
- Weakening democracy & the constitution
 - increasing conflict in parliament
 - delink from citizens
 - challenges to norms and values
 - Government in conflict with citizens Life Esidimeni?
 - multiple "conflicts" in society race & identity
- politics of cooperation & moderation or radicalism & violence?

Trends in democratic systems

- Distress & decline in democratic systems
 - declining confidence in
 - political parties
 - parliaments
 - politicians & "the political class"
 - capacity & competence of governments
 - availability of information fake & real
 - control of agenda what comes on/ when/ how
 - criteria for evaluation
 - performance of representative institutions
