#### POLITICAL

- · Attempt to balance 'power' and 'fear'
- Lack NS/NSS
- · Lack political will
- Ethnic/tribal preferences private protection force
- Do too little, too late
- Deploy AF's for Law Enforcement duties
- · 'Regime change' concerns
- Political blackmail
- Accept 'free' advice and training
- If intelligence clashes with narrative, discard

#### INTELLIGENCE

- Lack of NSS impacts on NDS
- · Highly politicised
- Use intel to ensure self-preservation
- Poor leadership
- Overreliance on 'partners' for intel
- Lack of resources
- Lack HUMINT no Intel Process
- Inability to conduct recce/pseudo ops
- Discarded if narrative not matched
- Poorly trained
- Failure to exploit all sources / resources
- · Result is being 'caught off guard'

#### **MILITARY**

- Stagnation
- Politicised
- Corruption
- Irrelevant ORBATs
- Top heavy lack understanding
- Problematic C\*ISR
- Outdated, unworkable doctrines/TTPs result in poor standards
- Poor leadership/Discipline/Training
- Poorly-equipped
- Poor welfare
- Lack of trust from LP and human rights violations
- Not mission trained/qualified
- Strategic, Operational, and tactical deficit

## ECONOMIC

- Bloated armies result in excessive costs
- 'Incentives' to purchase irrelevant equipment
- Procurement of incorrect equipt
- · 'Free' means expensive
- Collusion with AGFS/#operational ability impacted
- · Reliant on foreign suppliers costs

### FOREIGN

- Foreign suppt often to both sides
- · One-sided 'partnerships'
- · Poor 'free' advice
- Trained to fail
- · Irrelevant equipt dumped
- Arrogance of foreign trainers

#### THREATS

- Lack Int and NSS
- · Result is being caught off balance
- Don't understand the threat
- Result is poor campaign strategies/op designs
- Don't understand cause of threats
  - Domestic
  - Foreign
- Media coverage compromises operations
- Incorrectly structured to counter threats
- Inadequate approaches result in failure

# ALIGN/SYNCHRONISE COMBAT POWER

Inability to align and synchronise elements of combat power:

- Intelligence
- Manoeuvre
- Firepower
- Logistical support
- Protection
- Leadership
- Espirit de Corps

Troops can only do what they are trained to do—no bad troops, only bad leaders
